Institution: China-EU School of Law at the China University of Political Science and Law

Location: Beijing, China

As the first Sino-foreign law school in China, the China-EU School of Law (CESL) is a unique law school. Approximately 300 master's students are studying in the Master of Chinese Law and the Master of European and International Law (MEIL) at CESL. To support the professors from Europe who fly to China to teach in the MEIL programme ('Flying Faculty'), we are looking to expand our faculty and recruit a number of more permanent assistant professors.

Successful candidates will ideally begin at the beginning of September 2019. They will take over mainly practical teaching classes (tutorials) on various law topics in the field of Public International Law and Human Rights (Legal Foundations of Public International Law; International Organisations; International Dimension of Human Rights; European Human Rights Law; Legal Traditions) and EU Law/European Business Law (Legal Foundations of EU Law and Political Systems; Area of Freedom, Security and Justice; Internal Market; External Relations/CCP; Competition Law; European Private Law). Further, assistant professors will assist in activities such as preparation for the master's thesis. Assistant professors will also be given the possibility to conduct research at CESL.

We seek candidates with excellent written and oral communication skills, practice and teaching experience.

Qualifications required

• Full European law degrees (Bachelor + Master), candidates with a PhD in law are particularly invited to apply





- Candidates should have a proven record of previous teaching experience at a law school outside of China for at least two years
- Willing to commit to a period of no less than 3 months from approximately 1 September to 1 December 2019 (if interested in a longer teaching stay combined with research, please indicate this in your cover letter along with your motivation and proposed duration of stay, and it will be considered on a caseby-case basis)
- Ability to teach in fluent English
